under Permit No. G-6039 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 15, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW_4 NE $_4$, as projected within Blackerby DLC, Section 9, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; 1150 feet South and 1370 feet West from NE Corner, SE_4 NE $_4$, Section 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

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conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
