CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That R. J. Stanbro

of **Prairie City**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of the overflow water of Graham Creek a tributary of John Day River,

for the purposes of irrigation, to be appropriated under Permit number 4107, being Certificate number 4931,

under Reservoir Permit No. R451 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 2, 1919;**

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed **3** acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Section **Ten (10)**, Tp. 14 S., R. 34 E., W. M.
