## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** WILLIAM C. RHODA

of Route 1, Box 149, Scio, State of Oregon 97374, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Thomas Creek for Tract 1 and Gopenny Creek for Tract  
2

a tributary of South Santiam River for the purpose of  
stock drinking directly from the sources and is limited not to exceed 60 head

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Linn County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 15; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1870

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed be further limited to  
the provisions of Finding No. 55 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the - - - - -

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

Tract 1

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 11

Tract 2

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 14

T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Being within that tract of land described as follows:


Beginning at a point which is 87.40 rods West of the Southeast corner of the  
Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 14 in Township 10 South,  
of Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, and running thence North  
200 rods more or less to the center of Thomas Creek; thence Westerly down the  
center of said creek 26  $\frac{3}{5}$  rods; thence South 200 rods more or less to a  
point due West of the place of beginning; thence East to the place of beginning,  
containing 33.25 acres more or less.

Beginning at a point 114 rods West of the Southeast corner of the Northwest  
quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 14, in Township 10 South, Range 1  
West of the Willamette Meridian, in Linn County, Oregon, and running thence  
North 200 rods to center of Thomas Creek; thence West in the center of said  
creek 56  $\frac{2}{5}$  rods; thence South 200 rods; thence East 56  $\frac{2}{5}$  rods to the place  
of beginning, containing 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less, situated in Linn County,  
Oregon.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
