CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ELDON G. AND DONNA L. POWELL

of Star Route, Kimberly, State of Oregon 97848, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork John Day River

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 50.0 acres

under Permit No. 17695 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 25, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.63 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M.; Simas Ditch - 200 feet South and 1420 feet East from C $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 15

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M.; 800 feet South and 150 feet West from E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent of each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to September 30th of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

20.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
30.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$
Section 15
T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 19, 1978 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 28069, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
