## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

under Permit No. 4036 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 3, 1919

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.51 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion;  $SW_4$  NE4, Section 7, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W.M.; 1800 feet South and 975 feet East from  $N_4$  Corner, Section 7

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 SE4, Section 16, T. 9 S., R. 26 E., W.M.; 800 feet South and 150 feet West from E4 Corner, Section 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 19, 1978 and together with certificates of water right recorded at pages 48237, Volume 41 and 48658, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate recorded at page 3970, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
