CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAN CAMERON

of Rogue River, State of Oregon 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Pleasant Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek for the purpose of
mining, November 1st to June 1st, in Tract No. 1 and mining, November 1st to
June 1st, in Tract No. 3

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1860 for Tract No. 1 and 1861 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.0 cubic feet per
second for Tract No. 1 and 5.0 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 3

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Tract No. 1

Placer mines located in
Sections 15, 22, and 27
T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

Tract No. 3

Placer mines located in
Sections 22 and 28
T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 16127, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on June 20, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4415.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
