CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM BUTLER

of Juntura, State of Oregon 97911, has
 a right to the use of the waters of
 Bendier Creek and Warm Springs

a tributary of Malheur River for the purpose of
 irrigation of 2.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 4.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the
 right thereby confirmed dates from January, 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1½ acre feet per
 acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30 day
 period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season,
 diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per
 acre, if available at the original points of diversion; Bendier Creek and*
 The point of diversion is located in the SW¼ NE¼, SE¼ SW¼, Section 36, T. 18 S., R. 37
 E., W.M.; Bendier Creek (Bendier and Warm Springs Ditch), Warm Springs Creek -
 80 feet North and 300 feet West from S¼ Corner, Section 36

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
 follows:

*Warm Springs Creek, SW¼ NE¼, Section 36, T. 18 S., R. 37 E., W.M.; (Bendier
 and Warm Springs Ditch)


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 11, 1964, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 31666, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 6960, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
