CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That Robert M. Betts and Carl Zimmerman

State of , has made proof Cornucopia Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed stream for the purpose of irrigation a tributary of Pine Creek of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 4296 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 25, 1919;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

1.06 cubic feet per second.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: Twenty (20) acres in the Southwest Cuarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW:NE2), Twenty (20) acres in the Northeast Cuarter of the Southeast Cuarter (NE SE) of Section Twenty-two (22); "wenty (20) acres in the North one-half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Cuarter (N2SW2SW4) of Section Twentythree (23); Fifteen (15) acres in the Northwest Cuarter of the Northwest Cuarter (NW1NW1), and Ten (10) acres in the Northwest Cuarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW NEL NV) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Seven (7). South. Range Forty-five (45) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon, being a total of 85 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
