## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

THOMAS A. AND PEARLEEN K. BENNET

of North Myrtle Route Box 263, Myrtle Creek, State of Oregon 97457, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs

a tributary of North Myrtle Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area, and stock purposes under Permit No. 40823 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 28, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, T. 28 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; Spring No. 1 - 200 feet North and 1050 feet West; Spring No. 2 - 300 feet North and 1040 feet West, both from S $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 33

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to-----of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and stock Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 4  
T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
