of Route 1, Echo , State of Oregon 97826 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Spike Well

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of irrigation of 6.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 108.7 acres

under Permit No. G-6097 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.44 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.; 350 feet North and 3130 feet East from SW Corner, Section 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

is appurtenant, is as follows:
