CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HULETTE JOHNSON

of Route 2, Box 237, Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon 97862, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of waste water

a tributary of Little Walla Walla River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 9.3 acres

under Permit No. 43005 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W.M.; 50 feet South and 50 feet East from W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel continuance of the waste water

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.3 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 34
T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
