CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PHIL BOOTH

of Route 2, Box 146, Sheridan, State of Oregon 97378, has
a right to the use of the waters of 2 springs

a tributary of Willamina Creek for the purpose of
domestic use of one family, irrigation of 0.5 acre, and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 262; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.009 cubic foot per second being 0.003 cubic foot per second each for domestic, irrigation and stock.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 5 South, Range 7 West, Willamette Meridian, being 1140 feet south and 1480 feet west; 1160 feet south and 1430 feet west; both from the NE corner Section 2.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


0.5 acre, domestic and stock NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1
T. 5 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Being within that tract of land lying west of the county road.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
