CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED R. FLORY

of Route 1, Box 1515, Wilsonville, State of Oregon 97070, has
a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring

a tributary of Baker Creek for the purpose of
domestic use of one family including the irrigation of 0.5 acre lawn and garden,
and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 262; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1862

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per
second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.005 cubic foot per
second for stock.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Johnson DLC 54,
Section 15, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian, being 970 feet
north and 490 feet east from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Section 15.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:


SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within J. Johnson DLC 54
Section 15
T. 4 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Being within that tract of land lying North of the county road.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
