CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLET N. GOHN

of 7485 SW Kimberly Ct., Beaverton, State of Oregon 97005, has
a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of South Yamhill River for the purpose of
domestic use of one family including the irrigation of 0.3 acre lawn and orchard

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circ at Court of the State of Oregon for
Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 262; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 5 South, Range 8
West, Willamette Meridian, being 270 feet south and 800 feet west from the NE $\frac{1}{4}$
corner Section 32.


A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32
T. 5 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
