CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That KENNETH and VIRGINIA LAMSON

of Route 1, Box 285, Willamina, State of Oregon 97396, has
a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring area

a tributary of Wilson Creek for the purpose of
domestic use of one family including the irrigation of 0.5 acre lawn and garden

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Yamhill County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 262; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from March 10, 1888

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 5 South, Range 7
West, Willamette Meridian, being 1300 feet north and 700 feet west from the SE
corner Section 28.


A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Section 28
T. 5 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
