CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatMcCLELLAN O. AND DOROTHY B. KNAPP
PAUL AND SANDY NORRIS

of Route 1, Box 89-A, Oakland, State of Oregon 97462, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean
irrigation of 40.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 36877 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 1, 1972
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.51 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$, as projected within N. Day DLC 40, NW $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$, as projected within H.B. Day DLC 53, both Section 31, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; Diversion No. 1 - 1960 feet South and 1640 feet East, Diversion No. 2 - 900 feet South and 1240 feet East, both from NW Corner, Section 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



6.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$
5.5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$
both as projected within N. Day DLC 40

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
