## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CITY OF ROSEBURG

of 900 SE Douglas, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 6.2 acres

under Permit No. 36020 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 11, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Leiser DLC 53, Section 14, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M.; 950 feet North and 190 feet West from SW Corner, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$   
Section 13

3.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$   
Section 14

both as projected within Leiser DLC 53  
T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 41523, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 20, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4496.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
