CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WARREN J. BILLICK

of Elkton, State of Oregon 97436, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 36.4 acres

under Permit No. 20376 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 8, 1951 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, T. 22 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; 1200 feet North and 200 feet East from SW Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
25.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 17
T. 22 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded at page 49238, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly describe the quantity of water and the number of acres irrigated.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
