## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of John Day River irrigation of 38.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 36672 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 8, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.97 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW4, Section 2, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.; 2320 feet South and 1550 feet East from NW corner, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortjeth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

26.8 acres Lot 3 (NE¼ NW¼) 9.6 acres Lot 4 (NW¼ NW¼) 1.1 acres SW¼ NW¼

1.2 acres SE's NW's

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 49029, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 21, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4495.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
