CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That T. RALPH PITTOCK

of Applegate, State of Oregon 97530, has
a right to the use of the waters of Humbug Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
irrigation of 17.0 acres in Tract No. 1, and Mining November 1st to May 1st, in
Tract No. 2

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1867

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.29 cubic foot per
second for Tract No. 1, and 6.00 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 2.

Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water
Resources Director entered on December 17, 1979.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
