CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONALD R. SMITH

of 1098 SE Clarey Avenue, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 0.8 acre

under Permit No. 28429 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 26, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 20, T. 36 S., R. 5 W., W.M.; 1610 feet South and 1050 feet West from the NE Corner, Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 20

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.3 acre Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 20
T. 36 S., R. 5 W., W.M.


This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded at page 34165, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly describe the point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
