CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VIRGIL and CATHERINE BERRY

of Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Clapboard Gulch

a tributary of East Fork Williams Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 2.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from 1880;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.034 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W.M.;
Miller Ditch: 250 feet North and 1100 feet West from E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 10.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

2.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Davidson DLC 30
Section 3
T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 29167, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on August 25, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4575.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
