## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed stream

a tributary of Siuslaw River domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.7 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29694 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (SW4 SE4), Section 23, T. 17 S., R. 10 W., W.M.; 2180 feet South and 3690 feet East from W4 Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.5 acre Lot 5 (NE¼ SE¼)
Section 23
T. 17 S., R. 10 W., W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 37223, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 25, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4554.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
