## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** Harry C. Brittan

of 6990 Cascade Highway NE, Silverton, State of Oregon 97381, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek

a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.0 acres

under Permit No. 27418 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 26, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 30, T6S, R1E, W.M., 560 feet South and 10 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner, Section 30;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T6S, R1E, W.M., 100 feet North and 1670 feet East from SW Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


1.7 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
0.3 acre NW 1/4 NW 1/4  
Section 30  
Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 14, 1979 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48683, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 33095, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
