CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HAZEL CARLETON

of Dufur, State of Oregon 97021, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

under Permit No. 5325 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 6, 1922

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W.M.; 220 feet South and 1050 feet East from NW Corner, Section 34

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W.M.; 10 feet South and 800 feet East from NW Corner, Section 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 5.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 35

T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the place of use of water and to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 30, 1979, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 4884, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
