## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** F. P. MAYS

of Tygh Valley, State of Oregon 97063, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Tygh Creek

a tributary of White River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.42 acres

under Permit No. 4368 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 2, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.30 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 8486, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on January 13, 1965, approving transfer application No. D-102, and NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 15, 1979, canceling part of the remaining right.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.
