or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN4 NE4, Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W.M.; 80 feet South and 960 feet East from NW Corner, Lot 1 (NE4 NW4), Section 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
