CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOYD M. and MIMI K. STOUT

of Star Route 1, Box 172, Alsea, State of Oregon 97324, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Alsea River

a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of irrigation of 21.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 20.0 acres

under Permit No. 33275 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 16, 1969 for 0.266 cubic foot per second and April 11, 1968 for 0.06 * that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.326 c.f.s. if available at the original point of diversion; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Haydon DLC 38, Section 32, T. 13 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; 1670 feet North and 250 feet West from SE Corner, DLC 38,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Haydon DLC 38, Section 32, T. 13 S., R. 7 W., W.M.; 2490 feet North and 425 feet West from SE Corner, DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


This certificate is issued to correctly describe the place of use as well as to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 2, 1978, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 46245, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 42367, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described., and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
