CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatHOWARD F. CARNES
c/o Department of Forestry

of 2600 State Street, Salem, State of Oregon 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean
irrigation of 155.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 22157 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 27, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.94 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Bay DLC 38, Section 2, T. 23 S., R. 8 W., W.M., South 43 $^{\circ}$ 30' West, 2050 feet from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, Section 2.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, both as projected within Bay DLC 38, T. 23 S., R. 8 W., W.M.; No. 1 - 440 feet South and 40 feet West, No. 2 - 250 feet South and 480 feet West, No. 3 - 320 feet North and 2160 feet West, all from SE corner, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


This certificate is issued to confirm changes in point of diversion approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered May 10, 1973 and April 13, 1978 and together with certificate of water right recorded at Page 46171, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 22393, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described., and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
