CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 117.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2892 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.46 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW_4 SE_4 , Section 7, T. 13 S., R. 34 E., W.M.; 2150 feet North and 3300 feet East from SW corner Section 7

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1_4 SE 1_4 , Section 7, T. 13 S., R. 34 E., W.M., Power Ditch - 1920 feet North and 1060 feet West from SE corner Section 7; SE 1_4 NE 1_4 , Section 10, T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W.M., Galbraith-Olp-Hall Ditch - 2900 feet North and 440 feet West from SE corner Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
