## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

*This Is to Certify, That* CARL SHEEDY & BETTY JANE SHEEDY

of P. O. Box 125, Canyon City, State of Oregon 97820, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Big Dog Creek and Little Pine Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of irrigation of 22.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 18.4 acres

under Permit No. 28418 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 8, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.015 cubic feet per second; being 0.577 cubic foot per second from Big Dog Creek and 0.438 cubic foot per second from Little Pine Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 9; NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 7, T. 14 S., R. 32 E., W.M.; Big Dog Creek - 3590 feet South and 5940 feet East; Little Pine Creek - 330 feet South and 100 feet West both from NE corner, Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the John Day River is more than 30 cubic feet per second at U.S.G.S. Gage No. 14-0465 and more than 20 cubic feet per second at U.S.G.S. Gage No. 14-0480;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


