CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That TANASBROOK

of P.O. Box 1009, Beaverton, State of Oregon 97005, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bronson Creek and Tanasbrook Reservoir No. 1, 2, and 3, constructed under Permit No. R-6024 a tributary of Beaverton Creek for the purpose of recreation

under Permit No. 37114 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 8, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Dustin DLC 60, Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 31, T. 1 N., R. 1 W., W.M.; No. 1 - 650 feet South and 100 feet East, No. 2 - 750 feet South and 700 feet East, No. 3 - 60 feet South and 1450 feet East, all from NW Corner, Section 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


