CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. A. & HELEN HOFFBUHR

of 2726 East Side Road, Jacksonville, State of Oregon 97530, has
a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River through the Swayne Ditch

a tributary of Rogue River
irrigation of 39.8 acres

for the purpose of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.995 cubic foot
per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T40S, R3W, WM; being 710
feet South and 995 feet East from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, Section 5.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:


12.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

19.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

This certificate supersedes the certificate recorded at page 38779, Volume 30,
State Record of Water Right Certificates, and together with certificate
recorded at page 47281, Volume 40, (confirming T-2575) describes the right
as corrected by a decree and order of the Circuit Court for Jackson County,
entered February 12, 1981.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
