CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FIELDS and STONE CORPORATION

of 14725 Williams Highway, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 15.7 acres

under Permit No. 27151 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 19, 1961 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Pennington DLC 41, Section 12, T38S, R5W, W; 1,030 feet South and 2,500 feet West from NE Corner, Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cfs at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.9 acres Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4)
1.8 acres Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4)
Section 12
Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM


This certificate is issued to correct and supersede certificate of water right recorded at page 31582, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly describe the lands irrigated.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
