## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** C.B. COLLINS

of 71 Black Oak Drive, Medford, State of Oregon 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Lake of the Woods

a tributary of Seldom Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family.

under Permit No. 42476 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 30, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 10, T37S, R5E, WM; 2465 feet North and 1409 feet East from SW Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 4 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ )

Section 10

Township 37 South, Range 5 East, WM


Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows: Lot 3, Block P, Lake of the Woods.

Water user is aware that this water right is junior in priority to all other rights on the Klamath River existing before the date of the filing of application No. 56687, and that the water available might be less than the amount stated herein if run-off in the Klamath River is insufficient to satisfy all rights with senior priority, including those of the United States under its 1905 filings, the Klamath River Compact, or under the decree of a court of competent jurisdiction.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
