## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JERRY A. AND JUDY L. ANTHONY

of P.O. Box 131, Brownsville, State of Oregon 97327, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooia River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.75 acre

under Permit No. 40370 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 14, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Brownsville Canal - NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Alford DLC 58, Section 4, T. 14 S., R. 2 W., W.M.; 710 feet North and 2930 feet East from SE Corner, Kirk DLC 57; Rediversion - SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Spalding DLC 41, Section 32, T. 13 S., R. 2 W., W.M.; 640 feet North and 500 feet East from SW Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.75 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Spalding DLC 41  
Section 32  
T. 13 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
