## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** WILLIAM K. REINER

of Star Route West, Mount Vernon, State of Oregon 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 20.2 acres

under Permit No. 8169 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 10, 1927

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, T13S, R28E, WM; 2080 feet North and 370 feet East from SW Corner, Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

20.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 15  
Township 13 South, Range 28 East, WM


This certificate is issued to correctly describe the location of the point of diversion and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 43567, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
