CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWARD S. HILLIS

of Rogue River, State of Oregon 97537, has
 a right to the use of the waters of
 Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
 irrigation of 0.3 acre

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right
 thereby confirmed dates from 1881;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot
 per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W.M.;
 Fielder or Hillis Ditch - 475 feet South and 120 feet East from NW Corner,
 Section 7.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
 follows:

0.3 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 12
 T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.
 being that part of the foregoing tract lying South of Evans Creek

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
 certificate recorded at page 32770, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right
 Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
 Director entered on October 28, 1980, approving transfer application No. 4573.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
 water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
 described.
