CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ED WOODCOCK

of Takilma, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of springs

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

under Permit No. 10895 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 26, 1933 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23 and NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 26, T40S, R8W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, throughout the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23 Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 11158, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 20, 1981.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
