## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES L. AND BEBE J. FLEMING

of 28041 Bridges Lane, Eugene, State of Oregon 97402, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Amazon Creek

a tributary of Long Tom River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.1 acres

under Permit No. 37288 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Breeding DLC 55, Section 24, T17S, R5W, WM; 340 feet South and 710 feet East from NE Corner, DLC 49

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.0 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
both as projected within Breeding DLC 55  
Section 24  
Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
