CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That McKay Investment Company

of 2300 Oakmont Way, Eugene, State of Oregon 97401, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Dorla Well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of cooling source for building heat and air conditioning

under Permit No. G-5617 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 15, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T17S, R3W, WM; 280 feet North and 780 feet East from SW corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



Section 29
Township 17 South, Range 3 West, WM

This right is subject to the provision that use of water for air conditioning in excess of 5,000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the system recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was drawn.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
