CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN R. & HELEN I. BUCKLES

of 650 E. Main Street, Sheridan, State of Oregon 97378, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Yamhill River

a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.2 acre

under Permit No. 40003 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 16, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Graves DLC 57, Section 35, T5S, R6W, WM; 1620 feet North and 1450 feet West from E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner, Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


0.2 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Faulconer DLC 43
Section 35
Township 5 South, Range 6 West, WM

Land on which water is to be used is further described as: The easterly 52 feet of Lot 7 and the westerly 65 feet of Lot 8 in Block 11, Faulconer's First Addition to the City of Sheridan.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
