CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LEO F. STICKA

of Route 2, Box 365, Gaston, State of Oregon 97119, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, irrigation of 0.5 acre and stock

under Permit No. 42110 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 13, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use, 0.006 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T2S, R3W, WM; 1910 feet North and 780 feet East from SW corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock, Domestic and 0.5 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
