CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLIFFORD and ALICE MARIE COUNTS and
ARNOLD R. and OPAL G. COUNTS

of 1449 Reservoir Street, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
North Deer Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of
irrigation of 9.3 acres

under Permit No. 3732 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
February 4, 1918
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within James Cox DLC 44

7.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within James Cox DLC 44


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 3399, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources
Director approving Transfer Applications 4228, 4633, and 4639, and correctly
describing the place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture
or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the
Water Policy Review Board.
