## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 8.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 8572 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SE $_4$  SE $_4$ ), Section 21, T34S, R1W, WM; 500 feet North and 1,140 feet West from SE Carner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.5 acres Lot 4 (SE¼ SE¼)
Section 21
Township 34 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 44189, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 27, 1981, approving Transfer Application 4746.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
