CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LORETTA OWENS, c/o L.A. and NANCY C. WEHDE

of 2761 Pleasant Creek Road, Rogue River, State of Oregon 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Pleasant Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 20 acres, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from
1877

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per
second, if available at the original point of diversion, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28,
T34S, R4W, WM - Lower Wakeman Ditch.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T34S, R4W, WM; 1,180 feet
North and 200 feet East from SW Corner, Section 34, for irrigation and stock;
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, T34S, R4W, WM; Lower Wakeman Ditch, for domestic.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	10.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 34	Section 3
Township 34 South, Range 4 West, WM	Township 33 South, Range 4 West, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 16130, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provision of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered April 24, 1973, and is issued to confirm a change in point of
diversion and place of use of water for irrigation and stock use approved by the
same order and supersedes certificate 16130.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 51.610 pertaining to forfeiture
or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
