under Permit No. 12247 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 6, 1936;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE½ SE½, Section 31, T38S, R5W, WM; John Ditch - 600 feet North and 150 feet West from SE Corner, Section 31.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NW4, Section 5, T39S, R5W, WM; 650 feet South and 450 feet East from NW Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 14, 1963 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 13709, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
