that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-eightieths of one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated, and not to exceed one and one-half acre-feet per acre during any period of 30 days during the irrigation season, if available at the original point of diversion; SW4 NE4, Section 26, T1S, R48E, WM; Schleuer Creek Ditch - 450 feet North and 2,125 feet West from* The point of diversion is located in the NE4 NW4, Section 25, T1S, R48E, WM; 1,160 feet South and 2,200 feet East from NW Corner, Section 25

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture and abandonment.
