## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BOONE T. HARRIS

of Route 2, Box 330, Corvallis, State of Oregon 97330, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Mercer Creek

a tributary of Powell Creek for the purpose of  
Orchard spraying

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Benton County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 367; that the priority of the right  
thereby confirmed dates from October 4, 1875

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within H. Banks DLC 66,  
Section 34, T12S, R6W, WM; NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within T. Linville DLC 47,  
Section 3, T13S, R6W, WM; 1870 feet North and 150 feet West; 1700 feet North  
and 30 feet East; both from the SE corner H. Banks DLC 48.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:



as projected within T. Linville DLC 47  
Section 3  
Township 13 South, Range 6 West, WM

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein  
described.
