

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MAYNARD W. McLAUGHLINof Route 2, Box 177, Monroe, State of Oregon 97456, has
a right to the use of the waters of two springsa tributary of Hawley Creek for the purpose of
domestic use for one family, stock use and irrigation of 0.5 acreand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Benton County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 367; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from 1891that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per
second, being 0.005 cfs each for domestic, stock and irrigation.The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within C. Hawley DLC 49,
Section 26, T14S, R6W, WM; 1120 feet North and 1860 feet East; 1140 feet North
and 1930 feet East: both from the West re-entrant corner C. Hawley DLC 49.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:Domestic, Stock & 0.5 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within C. Hawley DLC 49
Section 26
Township 14 South, Range 6 West, WMAnd said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
